

**VILLAGE OF CUYAHOGA HEIGHTS

2) Signage	4,000.00	
3) Fence for the Sallyport Area	1,685.00	
4) Additional Electrical Work	5,500.00	
5) Landscaping	<u>8,000.00</u>	
<i>Total Cost for Above Items:</i>	<u>\$24,985.00</u>	

The other items on the list were either budgeted items to run the jail or major purchases to be decided by Council.

Wherefore, there being no further business, the meeting ended at 8:00 p.m.
