## Property Tax News

Property tax for the Village is administered and collected by Cuyahoga County. The County then distributes taxes to all local entities. For each **one dollar** in property tax paid the county distributes those funds as follows:

School District	50.05 cents
Cuyahoga County	35.21 cents
<b>Village of Cuyahoga Heights</b>	<b>7.31 cents</b>
Library	4.11 cents
Vocational School District	3.32 cents

The Village receives **7.31 cents for each dollar paid** in property tax to assist with providing government services to our town.
