# East 49th Street Parking Lot

As many of you may know, in an effort to assist our East 49<sup>th</sup> Street residents that require additional parking from time to time for visitors, parties, etc., you are able to use the parking lot on the west side of the street. Please note that use of the parking lot will be by permit only; just as we do when a resident needs to rent Klima Gardens, the Village Hall, Bacci Park pavilions, and so forth. To secure your permit, please stop at the Village Hall during normal business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. and 1:00-4:30 p.m. No deposit fee is required.
