OTHER BUSINESS:

Ms. Biro passed out, and went over a statistical report on the Village that she received from Silverlode during the Economic Development Committee Meeting.

It was interesting to note that the Village population has increased for the last couple of years, in 2009 we were at 452 residents, and in 2015 we are now at 616. There is a large increase in younger resident's ages 5-14, but the largest increase in residents is between the ages of 40-54. Unfortunately, the largest decrease in population for the Village is between the ages of 60-85.

The Median Household Income for the Village is \$47,237.00. This is the lowest it has been since 2009. Total jobs within the Village peaked in 2008 at 6,487 right before the great recession, and in 2014 it was 5,160. Mayor Bacci said that right now he believes there are closer to 6,000 jobs in the Village, and Ms. Henley said she remembers back in the day when there were over 20,000 jobs in the Village.

The Mayor and Council thanked Ms. Biro for the information, and stated that Ricardo from Silverlode is a very hard working young man, and both he and Dennis McAndrew did a great job on the information we just went over, and do a great job overall in Economic Development for the Village.

Ms. Henley made the motion to go into the CIC, seconded by Mr. Bloam. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.

Mayor Bacci made the motion to go out of the CIC and back into the Workshop. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carried.
