POSITION SUMMARY

Under the general supervision the Lifeguard monitors the activities in the swimming area to prevent accidents and provides assistance to swimmers when necessary.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The following is an outline of the basic duties and responsibilities of the above-titled position. It describes the duties and responsibilities in the broad scope, and is not intended to be all-inclusive, and does not constitute a contract of employment. Individual(s) in this position may from time-to-time be assigned other duties as appropriate. This is a seasonal, part time position.

- Lifeguards must have and maintain a current Lifeguard and First Aid certification for the duration of the pool season
- Communicate and enforce all rules and regulations to patrons as needed, as well as communicate these incidents with manager on duty
- Remain alert at all times while on duty, have equipment ready at all times and handle all
 incidents in a manner appropriate manner according to their training
- Maintain the cleanliness and order of the pool area, including the baby pool
- Vacuum both the baby pool and the big pool
- Attend all required staff meetings and trainings: at least two hours per month
- Other duties as deemed necessary by a manager
- Lifeguards assigned as a Lifeguard 2 will also assist with training new lifeguard 1s on daily and routine duties, including but not limited to vacuuming, cleaning and learning the rotations

QUALIFICATIONS (KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES)

- Ability to positively interact with the general public
- Knowledge of life guarding, swim lessons instruction, CPR/First Aid, and public relations
- Ability to react effectively in emergency or stressful situations

Minimum

At least 16 years of age with current certifications in Lifeguard Training, First Aid/CPR.

Preferred

Life guard experience.

WORKING CONDITIONS (ENVIRONMENT/PHYSICAL DEMANDS) Environmental

Work is performed at an outdoor facility and will include exposure to all types of weather conditions, including exposure to the sun, and chemically treated water; and may involve occasional exposure to stressful situations such as rescuing drowning victim.

Physical/Mental

Swimming ability to perform rescue operations; sitting/standing for extended periods of time, and the physical ability to perform rescues when necessary. Occasional stressful/strenuous physical activity when reacting to emergency situations is possible.
