Company Profile

The facility is strategically located on the Cuyahoga River in Cleveland, Ohio with good access to the Port of Cleveland and Great Lakes shipping, as well as excellent highway and railroad transport. The plant operates two blast furnaces which feed two steelmaking facilities. It consists of the former LTV and Republic Steel plants and has stood on this site since 1913 on the East Side (Corrigan McKinney Steel) and 1914 on the West Side (Otis Steel) of the river. Products made at this location are hot-rolled, cold-rolled and hot-dipped galvanized sheet and semi-finished (slabs). Markets this plant serves include automotive, converters and tubular applications.
