Company Profile

Founded in 1847, Cleveland-Cliffs has been traditionally recognized as the largest and oldest independent iron ore mining company in the United States. Today, Cleveland-Cliffs is the largest flat-rolled steel company and the largest iron ore pellet producer in North America. The company is vertically integrated from mining through iron making, steelmaking, rolling, finishing and downstream with hot and cold stamping of steel parts and components. Cliffs has the unique advantage of being self-sufficient with its production of raw materials for its steel manufacturing, which includes iron ore pellets, hot briquetted iron (HBI) feedstock and coking coal. In December 2020, Cleveland-Cliffs' transformation into a fully integrated high-value steel enterprise was completed with its acquisition of ArcelorMittal USA. This acquisition positioned Cleveland-Cliffs more competitively in an increasingly quality-focused marketplace, and amplified its position in the discerning automotive steel marketplace, and further improved its position in important U.S. markets such as construction, appliances, infrastructure, machinery and equipment.
