On the Ballot:

In the August 2, 2022 Primary Election voters will elect Democratic and Republican candidates for Ohio House and Ohio Senate seats as well as State Central Committee members.

The winners of the Ohio House and Ohio Senate contests will advance to the November 8, 2022 General Election.

Voters may choose a Democratic or Republican ballot even if they are not a member of either political party. The type of ballot that is selected will determine or change the voter's political party.

Check Your District Information:

There are new Ohio House and Ohio Senate district boundaries. It is important for voters to know their new districts so they can become familiar with the candidates and the areas that they will represent.

What ID should I bring?

- 9 Acceptable forms of ID include an unexpired Ohio Driver License, State ID Card, Interim Documentation with your former address, Military ID, or current (within the last 12 months) utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government documents with your name and current address, when your current address is in the pollbook.
- Vour passport or any notice from a Board of Elections, including this notice, is NQI an acceptable form of ID for voting purposes.


