## The Village of Cuyahoga Heights

The Village invites residents to honor departed family members through the planting of a memorial tree in Bacci Park. The policy is intended to clarify the terms, conditions, and requirements for this method of remembering the departed.

- ✓ All memorial trees will be planted on or about April 28<sup>th</sup> (Arbor Day) in odd years.
- ✓ Current residents of the Village may purchase a tree to be planted on behalf of a deceased family member(s) which will be planted in Bacci Park. The departed need not have been a resident of the Village.
- ✓ Non-residents may purchase a tree to be planted on behalf of a deceased resident. The departed must have resided in the Village at some point during their lifetime.
- ✓ The Village reserves the right to select the location of the memorial tree.
- ✓ The Village reserves the right to select the species to be used for the memorial tree. The Village will work with the individual purchasing the memorial tree to determine which of the follow species they would prefer: White Oak, Red Oak, Norway Maple, Green Mountain Sugar Maple or Red Maple.
- ✓ The Village shall charge \$200 for the purchase of a tree, its planting and initial maintenance, and any memorial plaque (if applicable).
- ✓ The Village shall use best management practices to assist the memorial tree so that it survives and thrives. However, the Village does not guarantee that a memorial tree will survive and is not responsible for the replacement of a memorial tree if it dies, is knocked over or otherwise in need of removal. For example, the Village reserves the right to remove a tree that has been planted in memory of the departed if deemed necessary due to vandalism, disease, pestilence etc.
