Job Requirements for all positions:

- All Park Monitors must be 16 years old by March 1, 2024.
- Concession Stand Cashiers, Pool Attendants, Lifeguards and Playground Monitors must be 15 years old by June 1, 2024.
- All Concession Stand Cashiers must possess proficient math skills, have an outgoing personality, and must be available to work nights and weekends.
- Lifeguards must be a Certified Lifeguard, CPR Certified and WSI (Water Safety Instructor - if applicable).
- Applications <u>must</u> be turned in by 4:00 p.m. on <u>March 15, 2024</u> for
 Concession Stand and Park Monitors and by 4:00 p.m. on <u>April 5, 2024</u> for the <u>Pool</u>.
 Applications <u>will not</u> be accepted after these dates.

IN HOME RECYCLING

Aluminum Cups Empty and rinse. No straws.

Cans Empty and rinse.



Cardboard Empty and flatten.

Cups (Plastic) Empty and rinse. No straws. Discard lids.

Glass Bottles and Jars Empty and rinse.



Paper and Boxes Empty and flatten boxes.


Plastic Bottles and Jugs & Tubs Empty and rinse.

It's important to recycle correctly. Some items don't belong in your recycling bin.




Many items can be recycled, reused or donated elsewhere.
