Job Requirements for all positions:

- All Park Monitors must be **16** years old by **March 1, 2024**.
- Concession Stand Cashiers, Pool Attendants, Lifeguards and Playground Monitors must be **15** years old by **June 1, 2024**.
- All Concession Stand Cashiers must possess proficient math skills, have an outgoing personality, and must be available to work nights and weekends.
- Lifeguards must be a Certified Lifeguard, CPR Certified and WSI (Water Safety Instructor - if applicable).
- Applications **must** be turned in by 4:00 p.m. on **March 15, 2024** for **Concession Stand and Park Monitors** and by 4:00 p.m. on **April 5, 2024** for the **Pool**.
Applications will not be accepted after these dates.

IN HOME RECYCLING

Recycle right in your home by placing only these items in your recycling. Items should be loose - unbagged - in your recycling bin.



Aluminum Cups Empty and rinse. No straws.



Cups (Plastic) Empty and rinse. No straws. Discard lids.

Cans Empty and rinse.



Glass Bottles and Jars Empty and rinse.



Cardboard Empty and flatten.



Paper and Boxes Empty and flatten boxes.

Plastic Bottles and Jugs & Tubs Empty and rinse.



Leave These Out of Your Recycling
