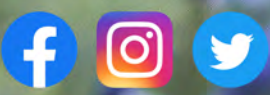

IN HOME RECYCLING

Recycle right in your home by placing only these items in your recycling. Items should be loose - unbagged - in your recycling bin.



Aluminum Cups Empty and rinse. No straws.

Cans Empty and rinse.



Cardboard Empty and flatten.



Cups (Plastic) Empty and rinse. No straws. Discard lids.

Glass Bottles and Jars Empty and rinse.



Paper and Boxes Empty and flatten boxes.



Plastic Bottles and Jugs & Tubs Empty and rinse.



Leave These Out of Your Recycling

It's important to recycle correctly. Some items don't belong in your recycling bin.

OTHER RECYCLING

Many items can be recycled, reused or donated elsewhere.

RiverSweep 2024 Celebrates 35 Years of Community Cleanups

Since 1989, Canalway's RiverSweep has been bringing together volunteers to protect the Cuyahoga River from litter and illegal dumping. During this time, more than 20 thousand volunteers have helped recycle 24,757 illegally discarded tires and picked up 1.5 million pounds of trash. This annual cleanup is one of Ohio largest one-day litter cleanups. It has helped communities reduce public dumping and encouraged the creation of parks and trails.
