## HOW DO I QUALIFY?

- Open to owners and renters of homes in the targeted cities
- Children five years old or younger living in the home
- Proof of household income

## WHAT CAN BE FIXED?

Windows, doors, porches and outside of home based on condition

## HOW MUCH MONEY IS AVAILABLE?

- Up to \$8,000 of total work per home
- Landlords required to pay a minimum of \$500
